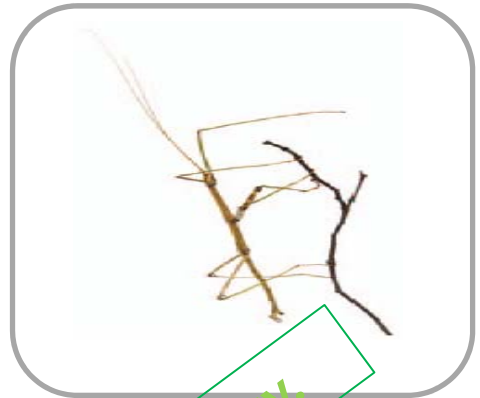
Stick Insect
