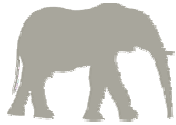

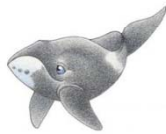

The superlative form is **the + -est** or **most**

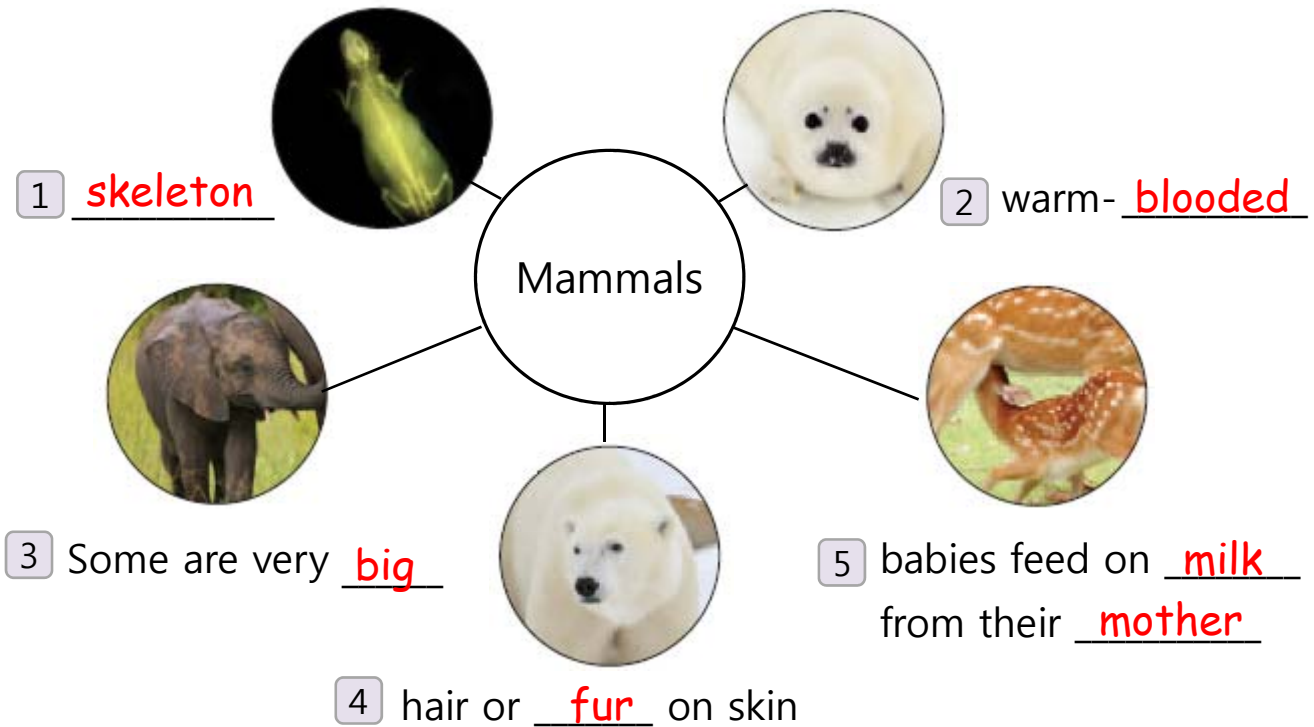
In general, we use **-est** for short words.
