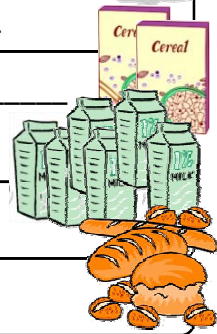
► **Who** was the main character in the story?
