Frédéric Chopin was born in Poland in 1810. As a child, he liked playing with the _____. Soon he was learning the piano and then composing his own music for it. People called him a _____, and he gave his first concert at age 8. Soon after finishing music school, he left Poland. In Paris he met and became friends with Franz Liszt. The _____ Robert Schumann and Felix Mendelssohn also admired Chopin. In Paris he made money by giving piano lessons. He was _____ for Poland, but could not return. This is because Russia controlled Poland, and Chopin refused to ask the Russian Embassy for a passport. Chopin never married. But he lived with the famous writer George Sand for ten years. His sister cared for him in the last years of his life. He died of _____ in 1849. He had written many masterpieces during his life, mostly for the piano. Two hundred years later, people still play and love Chopin's music.
