Most people live in cities, but some choose to live in very cold climates. The people of Northern Canada are called the Inuit. They live on a tundra, so there are no trees. The Inuit hunt and fish. Because there are no trees, they do not cook their food. They use seal skin to keep their clothes waterproof. They use sleds as a mode of transportation. The Sami people live near the Arctic Circle. The winters are long, and it is very cold. The Sami people travel with their reindeer herds. They use reindeer for their clothing, food, and shelter. Mongolia is another cold place to live. Mongolians are semi-nomadic people who also herd animals. They use camels and horses for transportation. They make cashmere from goats. They live in tents called gers. These have a fireplace in the center for warmth. It may be more difficult to live in cold places, but the Inuit, the Sami, and Mongolians are able to survive well.
