Scavengers, which feed on rotting things, come in many different kinds. Some mammals, including hyenas and bears, are both hunters and scavengers. Rats are probably the most infamous scavengers. Other animals that scavenge are birds. Vultures feed on dead meat. Many vultures lack feathers on their heads so that carrion cannot stick to the feathers and make them sick. Other bird scavengers are crows and seagulls. In the ocean, sharks help keep the water clean by eating dead and wounded fish. Remoras attach themselves to sharks and other large fish. They try to eat what the larger fish doesn't. Some insects are also important scavengers. Houseflies both eat rotting food and lay their eggs in it. Cockroaches can live in places most animals can't, and they can eat anything. But the smallest scavengers are dust mites and microbes. People tend to find most scavengers disgusting. However, they keep our ecosystem healthy by recycling dead material.
