lagoon	noun	석호	a shallow pond or channel of water	The children enjoyed relaxing by the lagoon.
cliff	noun	남떠러지, 벼랑	a surface of rock, ice, or earth that extends downward very sharply	From the top of the cliff, he could see the whole valley below.
dune	noun	모래 언덕	a hill made of sand that is formed by the wind	The wind blows sand and makes dunes in the desert.
shelf	noun	암상, 선반모양의 것	a flat, narrow surface on an area of rock or sand	Put all these books on a shelf.
marsh	noun	늪, 습지	an area of low land that is always wet and soft and has a lot of plants	You can usually find many dangerous animals living in a marsh, such as poisonous snakes.
