fire hydrant	noun	소화전	a metal pipe that carries water	Somebody opened the fire hydrant and the water went everywhere.
reflective	adj	반사하는	having the ability to reflect light, heat, or sound	Runners wear reflective jackets when they jog at night.
hose	noun	호스, 수도용 관	a tube that carries a liquid	My neighbor uses a long hose to water his garden every day.
burn	verb	불타다	to be on fire	The woman shouted for help when she saw her house burning.
bush	noun	덤불	grass or other low plants	The bushes in my garden need water.
explosion	noun	폭발, 파열	the act of something bursting into small pieces loudly	The gas from the broken kitchen stove caused an explosion.
ventilate	verb	통풍시키다, 환기하다	to allow fresh air to move and circulate around a room	We ventilated the bathroom to remove the bad smell.
