put on	idiom	입다	to apply a cosmetic to the face to improve one's looks	I put on my new socks.
clothes	noun	옷, 의복	things made from cloth that people wear on their bodies, such as shirts and dresses	I have four layers of clothes on.
face paint	noun	분장물감	paint used to decorate people's faces	Don't enjoy face painting too often because the brushes can have bacteria.
firefighter	noun	소방수	a person whose job is stopping and putting out fires	The brave firefighter saved the woman's life and rescued her from the burning house.
dancer	noun	춤추는 사람, 무용가	a person who is dancing, or whose job is to dance	She's a dancer with the Royal Ballet.
pirate	noun	해적, 약탈자	a person who attacks ships in order to STEAL things on them	The pirates got on the ship and took the gold coins.
