| servant | noun | 하인, 종, 부하 | a person who works in another person's house | I hired a servant to help care for the children. |
| knock | verb | 노크하다 | to strike something with a hand or an object in order to attract the notice of the people | Late at night, someone knocked on my door. |
| search | verb | 찾다, 수색하다 | to look carefully through something in order to find something or someone | I searched everywhere but I still couldn't find my dog. |
| real | adj | 진짜의 | not being artificial | The ring was made of real gold. |
| sensitive | adj | 민감한 | reacting negatively to particular influences or environments | Some plants are sensitive to light. |
| thunder | noun | 천둥 | the loud sound that comes from the sky, usually during a storm, and is produced by LIGHTNING | The cats always hide under the bed when they hear rain and thunder. |
| shelter | noun | 은신처, 피난처 | a building or structure that protects or covers people or things | They built a shelter to protect themselves from the sun. |
| storm | noun | 폭풍 | very heavy rain usually with thunder and lightening | We told each other ghost stories in the storm. |
| mattress | noun | 매트리스 | the thick soft part of a bed that you lie in | Our mattress is old and worn. |
| pile | verb | 쌓다, 포개다 | to put things on top of each other | Peter piled his books on the table. |
| marry | verb | ~와 결혼하다 | to take someone as your husband or wife in a legal union | Sandra asked Saul to marry her. |
| stay | verb | 체류하다 | to live somewhere for a short amount of time | My mother made me stay home today. |
| terrible | adj | 극심한 | very serious or very unpleasant | Juan has a terrible cold. |
| awake | adj | 깨어 있는 | not being asleep | Melissa stayed awake all night thinking about Bobby. |
