breathe	verb	숨쉬다, 호흡하다	to take air into and push it out of the lungs	We cannot breathe underwater.
dive	verb	(물 속으로) 뛰어들다	to jump into water head first with your arms extended	Thomas dived into the swimming pool.
salty	adj	소금이 있는, 짠	containing or tasting like SALT	The food was too salty to eat.
source	noun	원천, 근원	the place or person from which something necessary or desired comes	The sea is the source of a lot of our food.
solid	adj	단단한, 고체의	being firm or hard	Crabs have solid shells.
absorb	verb	흡수하다	to take in a liquid or other substance	A dry cloth can absorb water.
float	verb	뜨다	to rest or move on a liquid without sinking beneath the surface	A rock will not float.
surface	noun	표면, 지면, 수면	the top layer of the ground or of water	Dolphins must come to the surface of the sea to breathe.
reach	verb	뻗치다	to be able to touch or hold something by extending the arm	I couldn't reach the top shelf.
tiny	adj	작은, 조그마한	being extremely little	The insect was so tiny I couldn't see it.
poison	noun	독, 독물	a substance that can cause sickness or death when it is consumed by a person or animal	Some plants have poison in them.
