ripe	adj	(과일·채소)가 익은	being completely developed and ready to be eaten	We love to eat ripe mangoes.
trick	verb	속이다	to be not honest with someone in order to obtain a result	The magician tricked the audience.
track	noun	지나간 자취, 흔적	a mark, sign, or line left by something moving that has gone by	The hunter is following the tracks in the forest.
slip	verb	미끄러지다	to begin to fall as a result of losing balance	The baby slipped onto the wet floor.
sweep	verb	청소하다, 쓸다	to clean a surface with a brush	The huge waves swept the fishing boat and sunk it.
drown	verb	익사하다	to die because one has been under water and without air for too long	Many people drowned during the tsunami.
twig	noun	작은 가지	a small piece of wood that grows from a branch on a tree	The elephant broke the twigs with his long trunk.
admit	verb	인정하다	to take responsibility for an error or mistake	I admit that I left the door open and let the dog out.
know a few	verb	알게 하다, 손익하다	to behave in a way that makes others	He knows only a few Italian words, yet he

pretend	verb	~인세어나, 꾀이나	believe something that is untrue	pretends to speak fluently.
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
