weed	noun	잡초	a wild, unwanted plant that grows very quickly and prevents other more desirable plants from growing or developing properly	Before we can grow garden plants, we must get rid of these weeds.
rake	verb	갈퀴로 모으다	to move through or along something	You have to rake the grass gently so that the plants won't be destroyed.
flat	adj	평평한	having a smooth surface without changes in level	These days computer monitors have very flat screens.
soil	noun	흙, 땅	the surface material of the earth in which plants set roots	The farmer buried the seeds in the soil and watered them every day.
spade	noun	삽	a tool with a heavy metal blade attached, used for digging	My mothers is digging the soil in the garden using a sharp spade.
sow	verb	씨를 뿌리다	to plant seeds in an area of ground	She sows rose seeds in her garden every year.
sprinkle	verb	뿌리다	to shower water on plants	He sprinkled some oil and vinegar on the salad before eating it.
evenly	adv	대등하게	in a manner that affects or influences all parts equally	The father divided the money evenly among his children.
dirt	noun	흙, 진흙	loose soil or earth	The wind blew dirt into the house.
heap	noun	더미, 무더기	a large collection of things placed on top of one another in a disorderly and disorganized manner	My father has a heap of old newspapers in the garage.

kneel	verb	무릎 꿇다	to go down or rest on the knees or a knee	Some people kneel when they pray.
closely	adv	접근하여, 밀접하게	in a nearby or connected manner	The woman walked closely by her husband.
lead	verb	앞장서서 가다, 안내하다	to guide	Jonathan knows this path so we asked him to lead the way.
