erupt	verb	분출하다	to shoot out or spill hot rocks, smoke, and fire	The volcano erupted with an incredible force.
steam	noun	김, 증기	the hot gas that is produced when water boils	Steam was rising from the hot pot of water.
force	verb	억지로 시키다, 강요하다	to make a person or group do something	The manager forced the employees to work long hours without pay.
active	adj	활동하고 있는	not at rest	Butterflies are usually active during the day.
dormant	adj	휴면상태에 있는	not being active or growing but having the ability to become active or to grow later	The seeds that you just planted will remain dormant during the winter.
extinct	adj	꺼진, 끊어진, 활동을 멈춘	not active	This volcano was dangerous when it was active, but since it is now extinct, there is no danger.
crater	noun	분화구, кратер	a large hole in the earth's surface that is formed when a volcano erupts	The enormous rock hit the earth and left a
