attach	verb	붙이다, 달다	to join one thing to another	The mountain climber attached a rope to his climbing partner.
cable	noun	굵은 밧줄	a very strong rope usually made of many smaller wires	The bridge is held up by cables.
chain	noun	쇠사슬	a series of locking rings, usually made out of metal, used to connect things together	The engineers need 10 meters of chain for the pulley.
crane	noun	기중기, 크레인	a tall, metal machine that helps builders move or carry heavy objects by lifting them in the air	They lifted the large tree using a heavy crane.
flagpole	noun	깃대	a pole on which to raise a flag	You can see a flagpole in the center of the building.
lever	noun	지렛대, 지레	a strong bar made of metal used to lift or move heavy objects	The hand cart is a lever with wheels, often used for moving furniture.
load	noun	짐, 화물	a large, and usually heavy, amount of something to be moved	She was able to lift the load onto her shoulders.
pulley	noun	도르래	a device made from a wheel and a rope that is used to lift heavy objects	Egyptians used pulleys to move heavy stones when buiding the pyramids.
rod	noun	막대기, 지팡이	a straight, long, and thin pole or bar	The cruel man lifted a thin wooden rod and hit the dog with it.
safety	noun	안전, 무사	the state of being free from harm or danger	I'm worried about the safety of the construction workers on top of the building.
harness	noun	벨트	a set of straps for fastening something to a person's body	The race car driver strapped himself into his harness before the race.
slip	verb	미끄러지다	to begin to fall as a result of losing balance	The child slipped on a banana peel.
remove	verb	제거하다	to eliminate something	I use soap to remove all the dirt from the car.
