| bench | noun | 벤치, 긴 의자 | a long seat for two or more people that is usually outside | The old man sits on a bench at the park. |
| shoes | noun | 신발 | objects which you wear on your feet | I only have 3 pairs of shoes. |
| cut | verb | 베다, 자르다 | to divide or split something into pieces using a sharp tool | Please cut the piece of paper in half. |
| happy | adj | 행복한, 기쁜 | feeling pleased, content, or satisfied with regards to life or a particular situation | The cat looks happy to be here. |
| buy | verb | 구입하다, 사다 | to trade money for something | I can buy a pen with my pocket money. |
| money | noun | 돈, 금전, 화폐 | coins or bills used to buy things, usually earned by working | He is very careful to save his money. |
| see | verb | 보다 | to look at something with the eyes | What can you see? |
| work | verb | 일하다. | to complete labor | I work in a clothes store. |
| clothes | noun | 옷, 의복 | things made from cloth that people wear on their bodies, such as shirts and dresses | She always wears expensive clothes. |
| elf | noun | 요정 | a tiny creature found in many fairy tales, usually assisting the main character | Do you know the story of the Elves and the Shoemaker? |
