| vegetable | noun | 채소 | a plant that is raised and eaten as food | Many children don't like to eat vegetables. |
| reach | verb | 미치다, 닿다 | to be long enough to get to a certain place | The rope reaches far to the kitchen. |
| bamboo | noun | 대나무 | a plant that is light in weight with strong, empty stems that can be used to build things | The explorer used a boat made of bamboo to sail to different islands. |
| rice | noun | 밥, 쌀 | small white or brown grains taken from a rice plant that can be boiled and eaten | We are having rice and meat for dinner. |
| hunt | noun | 사냥하다 | to search for wild animals to kill, usually for food | Lions sometimes hunt alone. |
