electric	adj	전기의	using or relating to electricity	The electric heater is using too much energy.
iron	noun	철, 쇠	a common type of metal that is used to produce steel and other hard products	Steel has replaced iron in the building of bridges and buildings.
machine	noun	기계, 기계 장치	a device or piece of equipment that does work using moving parts and uses electricity or other forms of power	Machines can do tasks that are too difficult for humans.
magnet	noun	자석, 자철	an iron or steel object that is able to attract or push away other metals	Computer hard drives use magnets to read and store information.
metal	noun	금속, 합금	a hard substance such as iron, steel, gold, lead	The desk is too heavy to move because it's made of metal.
motor	noun	모터, 발동기	a part of a machine that makes it move or operate using power	This machine does not work because its motor is broken.
