| chair | noun | 의자 | a piece of furniture that is designed for a person to sit on, usually with four legs and a back | Fred doesn't like other people to sit in his chair. |
| hat | noun | 모자 | a piece of clothing that is shaped to fit and cover the head | She puts a hat on her head. |
| book | noun | 책, 서적 | a work of writing produced on sheets of paper that are held together in a protective cover | People can learn a lot from books. |
| doll | noun | 인형 | a small children's toy that looks like a baby or person | In fact, every second of every day, two Barbie dolls are sold somewhere in the world. |
| thing | noun | 것, 물건, 사물 | an object that is not named | My bed is the biggest thing in my bedroom. |
