footbridge	noun	보행자 전용 다리	a bridge used only by people	In our town, there is an old wooden footbridge over the small river.
stream	noun	시내, 개울	a small river	We crossed the stream over the small bridge before reaching her house.
produce	verb	제조하다	to manufacture something using machines	Hundreds of thousands of cars are produced in South Korea each year.
steel	noun	강철	a very strong metal which is made mainly from iron	Most large bridges in the world are made of iron and steel.
vehicle	noun	운송 수단, 탈것	an object that is used to move people or things from one place to another	My uncle's new car is a fine-looking vehicle.
destroy	verb	파괴하다, 부수다	to damage something so that it cannot be repaired	A huge bomb completely destroyed the tank.
burn	verb	태우다	to use as fuel for a fire	Coal burns slowly, keeping our room warm for a long time.
flood	noun	홍수	a flowing of water that covers an area that normally remains dry	In Thailand there were very heavy floods last year.
railroad track	noun	철로	a line of metal tracks for trains	We liked walking on the railroad tracks when we were kids.
lane	noun	차로	a marked strip of the road wide enough to for only one vehicle at a time	The driver moved his truck to the bus lane.
direction	noun	방향	the course on which someone or something is traveling	We had to stop at the gas station to ask for directions to the beach.

roadway	noun	도로, 차도	the strip of land over which a road passes	The police cleared the roadway for the parade.
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
