krill	noun	크릴 새우	a small, shrimp-like organism in the oceans	Krill is found in the Antarctic water of the Southern Ocean.
shrimp	noun	새우	a small shellfish found in salt water that can be eaten	My favorite food is fried rice with shrimp.
predator	noun	포식 동물, 육식 동물	an animal that feeds itself by killing and eating other animals	Wolves are predators who live and hunt in groups.
thawed-out	adj	녹은	no longer frozen	Take the ice cream out of the freezer now so it will be thawed-out in time for dinner.
ledge	noun	암봉	a flat shelf that sticks out from a wall of rock	There are many high and dangerous ledges on the Himalaya Mountain.
