melt	verb	녹이다, 용해하다	to change something from a solid into a liquid by heating it	Plastics melt when heated, then harden again when cooled.
container	noun	그릇, 용기	an object that is used to hold or store things	Glass containers are often safe to use in the microwave oven.
optical	adj	눈의, 시각의	relating to vision or helping people see	The company manufactures telescopes, microscopes, and other optical instruments.
fiber	noun	섬유	a thin thread made from natural or artificial material that can be used to make other things	I need a material that is made up of very fine fibers of glass.
polish	verb	윤내다, 닦다	to make something shiny and smooth by rubbing a particular material or substance onto it	Your shoes need to be polished with a clean rag before the school performance.
flatten	verb	평평하게 하다	make flat or flatter	It is important to flatten the rice with your palm when you make Sushi.
mold	verb	본뜨다	to press a soft substance into a certain shape	We want to know how to mold chocolate candy.
object	noun	대상, 물건	something that can be held, seen, or touched	Let's start by painting the objects on

object	noun	물건, 물체	something that is solid, but, if possible, but is not living	He is looking for screws that can secure the table.
screw	noun	나사, 나사못	a thin, pointed, metal object that is used to SECURE things together, such as pieces of wood	He is looking for screws that can secure the door handle.
crush	verb	눌러 부수다, 뭉개다	to press something very hard and damage it	The cans need to be crushed in the machine before the metal can be recycled.
