guide	verb	안내하다, 인도하다	to lead someone, or lead a group, especially in new or unknown place	She was able to guide her friends on a tour of her home city.
sign	noun	표지판, 간판	a public display of a message	There is a stop sign here at the corner.
direct	verb	지시하다	to cause something or someone to move or turn in a certain way	The policeman directs the traffic when the roads are crowded.
ahead	adv	앞으로, 앞에	in front of	The road is closed ahead, so we have to turn around.
carriage	noun	탈것, 차	a wheeled vehicle designed for comfort and elegance which was drawn by a horse	There were no empty seats in the train carriage.
carry	verb	나르다, 운반하다	to hold or support something as you move with it	Will you help me carry this box up the stairs?
power station	noun	발전소	an installation where electrical power is produced	The nuclear power station makes enough electricity to support our whole city.
electricity	noun	전기	a form of energy generated by the attraction between positive and negative charges, used for power	The light won't turn on because we have no electricity.
				The light is flickering.

flood	verb	범람시키다	to fill or cover an area with water	The whole city flooded after one month of heavy rains.
collapse	verb	무너지다	to suddenly fall down or break apart into pieces	The bridge is very old and looks like it will collapse soon.
