skeleton	noun	골격, 해골	all the bones of an animal or human that together form the framework of the body	The medical students studied the skeleton to learn more about the human body.
suck	verb	빨아들이다, 흡수하다	to pull or remove something with great power using the force of pressure or moving air or water	The plants sucked the moisture out of the ground.
pouch	noun	주머니	a pocket	The kangaroo keeps its babies in its pouch.
lumpy	adj	덩어리가 많은, 혹 투성이의	like or containing small sticky lumps	A sea lizard is covered with a lumpy skin.
spine	noun	등뼈, 척추	the line of bones that runs down the center of the back	The human spine is very important because it supports the entire body.
protect	verb	보호하다	to defend against harm or danger	A mother will always protect her child.
swallow	verb	삼키다	to take food or drink into the stomach through the mouth and throat	Swallow the food in your mouth before you speak.

poison	noun	독, 독물	a substance that can cause sickness or death when it is consumed by a person or animal	Romeo and Juliet killed themselves by swallowing poison.
shell	noun	(동물의) 껍데기, 등딱지	the hard, protective covering of an animal or insect	People make jewelry from the shells of many different sea creatures.
