adult	noun	성인	a person who is legally responsible for himself or herself	Adults take care of their young children until they can look after themselves.
chemical	noun	화학 제품	a substance created through a chemical process	Harmful chemicals from the factory are entering the river.
layer	noun	층	the amount of something that covers the surface of an area	A thick layer of dirt covered the entire floor.
pollution	noun	오염 물질, 오염원	the dirty or dangerous substances that are harmful to people, animals when released into an environment	Bicycles do not cause pollution like cars do.
shrub	noun	관목	a small leafed plant with many wooden stems	He cut down the trees and planted shrubs around the garden.
damp	adj	축축한	being somewhat wet, but not very wet	My clothes were damp, so I left them out to dry in the sun.
swamp	noun	늪, 습지	an area of land that is wet or covered with water	The children are looking for frogs in the swamp.
marsh	noun	습지, 늪	an area of low land that is always wet and soft and has a lot of plants	Many dangerous animals live in a marsh, such as poisonous snakes.
environment	noun	(자연) 환경	the natural world in which plants and animals live	Let's all think of some ways to help save the environment.
male	adj	남성의, 수컷의	related to or belonging to the sex that does not give birth	Male birds are often more colorful than females.

belong	verb	속하다, 소속하다	to be a member of a particular group and feel welcomed	Lizards belong to a group of reptiles.
collect	verb	모으다	to take things from several different areas or places and bring them together	The teacher asked me to collect the students' tests.
