trap	verb	덫으로 잡다	to catch a particular animal in a TRAP	The hunter dug a hole in the ground to trap the wild pig.
insect	noun	곤충, 벌레	a very small animal with six legs, and sometimes with wings	In the summer, many insects get into the house.
drop	noun	방울	a very small amount of a liquid that rounds as it falls	I felt drops of rain on my head.
sticky	adj	끈적거리는, 들러붙는	being covered in or made of a substance that can attach to different surfaces	After eating candy, their hands were sticky and needed to be washed.
liquid	noun	액체	something that is in a state of being neither a solid nor a gas	It is important to drink some form of liquid, such as water, every day.
trick	verb	속이다	to be not honest with someone in order to obtain a result	The salesman tried to trick the young man by asking for too much money.
trap	noun	덫, 올가미	something, usually a machine, used to catch and hold animals	We set up traps in the garage to catch the mice.
land	verb	상륙하다, 착륙하다	to come down to the surface or the ground	We were all waiting for the airplane to land.
pitcher	noun	물주전자	a device to hold and pour liquids	Please fill the pitcher with fresh ice water.
slippery	adj	미끄러운	having a surface that is smooth and hard to move on or hold onto	The ice made the road in front of our house slippery.
nectar	noun	과즙, 넥타	the sweet liquid found in plants	Bees are busy collecting nectar from flowers.
trapdoor	noun	작은 문	a lifting or sliding door that covers an opening	The policeman searched the room for a secret trapdoor under the carpet.
snap	verb	뚝 부러지다	to break suddenly	The hurricane caused the tree to snap in half.

disturb	verb	~을 방해하다, 훼방 놓다	to bother people while they are trying to do something, or prevent them from continuing	Please do not disturb me while I am working on this painting.
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
