skip	verb	뛰어다니다, 강충강충 뛰다	to move forward or proceed by taking fast steps and jumps	Skippping was one of the most popular games in the playground when I was young.
scooter	noun	스쿠터	a light motorcycle, usually with small wheels and a curved metal cover at the front to	My brother saved money and bought
