| hold | verb | 잡다 | to use hands or arms to carry or keep something | Hold my hand. |
| swing | noun | 그네 | – | I took Dad to the swings. |
| sandbox | noun | 모래놀이통 | – | Dad helped me to make a road in the sandbox. |
| know | verb | 알다 | – | He didn't know that. |
| take off | idiom | 벗다 | to remove clothing from one's or another's body | We take off our shoes and socks. |
| dough | noun | 반죽 | – | We sat at the dough table. |
| remember | verb | 기억하다 | to recall something from the past | I'll try to remember. |
| stroller | noun | 유모차 | – | I dressed Dad like a nurse and gave him a stroller with a baby in it. |
| voice | noun | 목소리 | the sounds from the mouth and the vocal organs | She has a great voice and could become famous. |
