narrow	adj	폭이 좁은, 좁다란	having a small width	He climbed up the narrow stairs.
base	noun	토대, 기반	the lowest or bottom surface of something that usually provides support for the rest of the structure	The base of the Statue of Liberty is 305 feet tall.
spread	verb	퍼뜨리다, 확산시키다	to cause something to cover or influence a greater area or number of people	The flu spread to her classmates.
crane	noun	기중기, 크레인	a tall, metal machine that helps builders move or carry heavy objects by lifting them in the air	A crane was used to lift the cars into the boat.
roadside	noun	길가	the side of a road	Two women were waiting for a taxi by the roadside.
store	verb	저장하다, 보관하다	to keep	We can store the vegetables and fruits in the freezer.
peg	noun	나무못	a small piece of wood attached to a wall as a place to hang clothing	You can fix the tent to the ground with metal pegs.
