paper	noun	종이	a sheet of flat, thin material, used to write or print on or, to wrap objects	Did you use paper today?
paint	verb	색칠하다	to cover a surface with paint	We write and we paint pictures on paper.
wood	noun	나무	the hard material of a tree that forms its base and branches	But how do people make paper from this wood?
lumberjack	noun	벌목꾼	a person who fells trees	Lumberjacks cut down the tall trees.
log	noun	통나무	a large, thick piece of a tree that has fallen or been cut	After that, the workers cut the trees into logs.
bark	noun	나무껍질	the tough outer covering that protects a tree or other plant	Then they take the bark off of the logs.
wood chipper	noun	톱밥제조기	a machine used for reducing wood into smaller woodchips	Next, the smaller logs go through a wood chipper.
labor	noun	노동	work, particularly when it is physically challenging	This hard labor can take many days.
mill	noun	제분소	a factory for making certain kinds of materials	Then the logs go to a paper mill.
roll	noun	둥근 통	paper, cloth, film, tape, or other material that has been rolled tightly in the shape of a tube	The workers put it onto big rolls.
