| cockroach | noun | 바퀴벌레 | an insect with a hard, flat wing and long antennae | Cockroaches can be found all over the earth. |
| claw | noun | 발톱 | a long, sharp, and usually curved nail of an animal | Each leg has two small claws at the end. |
| antenna (antennae) | noun | 더듬이 | sensitivity similar to that of a receptor organ | Two long antennae grow from a cockroach's head. |
| exoskeleton | noun | 외골격 | the hard outer skin of insects | They have a hard shell that is called an exoskeleton. |
| egg case | noun | 알상자 | a protective container for eggs | Most cockroaches lay egg cases. |
| dinosaur | noun | 공룡 | one of a group of reptiles that lived millions of years ago | They have been alive since the time of dinosaurs. |
| poison | noun | 독 | a substance that can cause sickness or death when it is consumed by a person or animal | People use poison to kill cockroaches and other bugs. |
| dead | adj | 죽은 | being no longer alive | Some people think the only good cockroach is a dead cockroach. |
| hold | verb | 잡다 | to use hands or arms to carry or keep something | Cockroaches are easy to hold and don't bite. |
| snack | noun | 간식 | a small amount of food that is less than a meal | In some countries such as Thailand, people eat cockroaches as a snack. |
