railcar	noun	궤도차	a wheeled vehicle adapted to the rails of railroad	They are made up of railcars.
rail yard	noun	역 구내	an area having a network of railway tracks and sidings for storage and maintenance of cars and engines	Freight trains bring goods to the rail yards.
crane	noun	기중기	a tall, metal machine that helps builders move or carry heavy objects by lifting them in the air	Cranes move the large cargo goods off of the railcars.
unload	verb	짐을 내리다	to remove something, or many things, from a car, ship, etc.	A crane unloads logs from a flat railcar.
container	noun	통, 용기	an object that is used to hold or store things	It carries containers, too.
cargo	noun	화물	the goods carried in a ship or plane	The cargo is put in containers in the cargo hold.
goods	noun	상품	objects produced to be sold	Goods are moved all around the world.
