| raw | adj | 날것의 | being uncooked | We prefer to eat raw vegetables. |
| pain | noun | 아픔, 고통 | a feeling of physical or mental hurt or suffering | Mary has a pain in her neck. |
| honey | noun | 꿀 | a thick, sweet, golden substance produced by bees from the sugary material collected from flowers | Bill always puts honey in his tea. |
| delight | noun | 기쁨, 즐거움 | a great pleasure or joy | It is a delight to watch children dancing. |
| powder | noun | 가루, 분말 | a dry substance in the form of very small, fine pieces or grains | They mixed a powder with water to make a sweet drink. |
| wrap | verb | 감싸다, 싸다 | to cover or enclose something with a thin material such as paper or cloth | My mother always wraps all of our presents. |
| treat | noun | 간식 | a special snack | Do you want a treat after dinner? |
| lollipop | noun | 막대 사탕 | hard candy on a stick | Children get free lollipops at the bank. |
