acid	noun	산성	a liquid that can break down materials by eating away at it	If you spill acid on your skin it may burn you.
bond	verb	붙다	to attach	Carbon bonds with oxygen to make carbon dioxide.
carbon	noun	탄소	a solid, black or dark gray element that is a part of living matter	Diamonds are a form of very hard carbon.
carbon dioxide	noun	이산화탄소	a gas compound made of carbon and oxygen that is in the air with a symbol of CO ₂	Trees take in carbon dioxide and give off oxygen.
compound	noun	화합물	the product made when two or more elements combine to make different matter	Carbon dioxide is a compound made from one part carbon and two parts oxygen.
decay	verb	부패하다	when dead matter breaks down into simple parts	After an animal dies, its body normally decays.
diamonds	noun	다이아몬드	a very hard, shiny form of carbon	Many diamonds are found under the ground in South Africa.
elements	noun	요소	the basic matter made of one kind of atom	The elements in water are hydrogen and oxygen.
food chain	noun	먹이 사슬	the series of plants and animals that depend on each other for food	We take carbon into our bodies through the food chain.
fossil fuels	noun	화석 연료	coal, oil, and gas formed from long ago plants and animals pressed into rock layers	Fossil fuels come in the form of oil and coal.
graphite	noun	흑연	a very soft, slick form of carbon	Graphite is used to make many different things, including pencils, golf clubs, and airplanes.

effect	noun	온실효과	extra co2 being added to it	the poles to melt and the sea level to rise.
limestone	noun	석회암	a kind of rock formed from shells of sea animals and containing carbon	Most people probably don't know that marble is a type of limestone.
magma	noun	마그마	a liquid form of rock that was melted at high heat	When magma from a volcano cools, it becomes hard rock again.
