dew	noun	이슬	small drops of water that form at night	During the night, a dragonfly may get covered with dew.
exoskeleton	noun	외골격	the hard outer skin of insects	The nymph comes out of its exoskeleton so that it can grow bigger.
fossil	noun	화석	an image in rock from what is left of animals or plants that lived long ago	Dragonfly fossils show that they lived on Earth even before the dinosaurs.
hatch	verb	부화하다	to come out of an egg	Dragonflies are predators from the first day they hatch out of their eggs.
hover	verb	멈들다	to stay in one place while flying	They can also hover in one place like a helicopter!
lens	noun	렌즈	the curved, clear covering of the eye that helps one see things	Each of your eyes has a clear curved covering, called a lens.
metamorphosis	noun	변형, 변태	the process of insects changing from one form to another	The change from egg to nymph and then adult is called metamorphosis.
migrate	noun	이동하다, 이주하다	to move regularly to a different place at a certain time of year	Scientists learned that some dragonflies migrate many miles.
molt	verb	털갈이 하다, 허물 벗다	to come out of an exoskeleton in order to grow	A new exoskeleton soon hardens. This process is called molting.
mosquito	noun	모기	a tiny flying insect that bites people and animals to drink their blood	They are very helpful because they eat mosquitoes.
nymph	noun	유충	a young insect that has not yet changed into its adult form	Baby dragonflies are nymphs.
perch	noun	햇대	a tree branch or other narrow stick that a bird stands on	Often a dragonfly has a favorite perch on which it sits.
predator	noun	포식 동물, 포식자	an animal that hunts other animals for food	Dragonflies are predators from the first day they hatch out of their eggs.
