disaster	noun	재난, 재해	a large and sudden emergency	Some believe these floods might be the worst natural disaster ever.
escape	verb	탈출하다	to get away	Some people have even escaped floods on their roofs!
faucet	noun	수도꼭지	the part of a sink from which water flows	Imagine holding a cup under the faucet of your kitchen sink.
flash flood	noun	갑작스런 홍수, 돌발 홍수	a flood that happens suddenly as a result of heavy rain	When strong thunderstorms pass through a city, flash flooding can happen.
germ	noun	세균	a very small living thing that causes sickness	The flood water is dirty and can carry harmful germs.
meteorologist	noun	기상학자	a scientist who studies the weather	Scientists who study weather, or meteorologists, are responsible for predicting weather.
shelter	noun	주거지, 피신처	a place where animals and people can live safely	Just like us, fish need shelter for homes and protection.
predict	verb	예측하다, 예견하다	to say what will happen in the future	This new science helps meteorologists predict fast moving storms and flash floods.
shallow	adj	얕은	not deep	Even shallow water is strong enough to pick you up.
silt	noun	유사, 토사	a mixture of salt and small pieces of rock in bodies of water	They wait for flood waters to bring helpful silt to their land.
sponge	noun	스폰지	a foamy tool used for cleaning that sucks up liquids	The soil acts as a sponge and sucks up water easily.

swell	verb	붓다, 부풀다	to grow larger or expand	They begin to swell and flow over the land.
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
