bump	noun	혹	a small area that is raised	If you feel any small bumps, look for a tick.
crust	noun	딱지	a dry, hard cover of a sore on the skin	They leave a brown or black crust inside and outside of the ear.
diagnose	verb	진단하다	to find out what is wrong	It may be difficult for your vet to diagnose whipworms.
external	adj	외부의, 외면의	the outside of something	These kinds of parasites are called external parasites.
Internal	adj	내부의, 내면의	the inside of something	Parasites inside an animal’s skin are called internal parasites.
medication	noun	약, 약물	something to make a sick animal better	They can be treated by special medication that you get from your vet.
microscope	noun	현미경	a machine used to look at small things that cannot be seen with the eyes	A microscope is the easiest way to see ear mites.
parasite	noun	기생충	something that lives on or inside another living thing	Make sure your pets avoid parasites so they don’t get sick.
remove	verb	제거하다	to take off	It is harder to remove parasites after a pet gets sick.
sticky	noun	끈적거리는, 달라붙는	a liquid that helps two things stay together	They make a sticky substance that helps them stay on.
tweezers	noun	핀셋, 족집게	small metal tool to grab and pull small things	The best way to pull a tick off the body is with tweezers.
veterinarian	noun	수의사	a doctor who takes care of animals	Take your pet to a veterinarian at least once a year.
attach	verb	붙이다	to join things together	This helps them stay attached to your pet.
infect	verb	감염시키다	to make sick with a disease	If the ear mites are very painful and infected, the vet may give the animal an antibiotic.
