audition	noun	오디션	to sing or dance in front of the people who decide who will be in a movie or play	Cindy had been waiting three years to audition for the lead role.
senior	noun	졸업반 학생	students in the last year of high school	The lead role usually went to seniors, so she had never had a chance before this year.
musical	noun	뮤지컬	a play or movie which is mostly singing	The Christmas musical was the biggest event of the year.
beam	verb	활짝 웃다	to smile happily	"I think you were wonderful," he beamed.
butterflies	adj	조마조마한	to feel so nervous that your stomach hurts	The next day, Cindy woke up with butterflies in her stomach.
cafeteria	noun	구내식당, 카페테리아	a lunchroom or dining hall in a school or office	Cindy saw Beth and Laura sitting in the cafeteria having lunch.
cast	noun	출연자	a group of performers with parts in a play or movie	She had been too busy meeting the cast of the Christmas musical for rehearsals.
costume	noun	의상	special clothing, such as for a performance	Once the musical had ended, Cindy changed out of her costume.
flyer	noun	전단지	a piece of paper giving information about an event	Cindy grabbed one of the flyers that had been stacked on the table below the sign.
mature	adj	어른스러운, 의젓한	being like an adult, not childish	"If most of us don't go, then they will realize they should do something more modern and mature next year."
nervous	adj	불안해 하는, 초조한	to become uneasy under stress	She was nervous, not just about the performance, but about keeping it a secret from her best friends.
panic	verb	겁에 질려 어쩔 줄 모르다	a sudden feeling of worry or fear	"Oh, no!" she said, panicking. "The play is about to begin."

rehearse	verb	예행 연습을 하다	to practice, especially for a performance	Usually the cast rehearsed three times a week.
rush	verb	서두르다, 급히 행동하다	to do something at great speed	"OK!" Cindy said and rushed off to the auditorium.
