area	noun	지역	the land within a given boundary	In the center of the United States is a large area known as the Great Plains.
occur	verb	발생하다	to happen	Tornadoes occur in many parts of the world.
column	noun	기둥	a tall and round shape, like a cylinder	A tornado is a quickly spinning column of air.
destroy	verb	파괴하다	to damage something badly so that it can no longer be used	Winds from a tornado can pick up cars and destroy houses.
form	noun	모양	a way something exists	Storm clouds form when warm air and cold air meet.
funnel	noun	깔때기	a cone shape that is wide at the top and narrow at the bottom	Most tornadoes have a “funnel shape.”
moisture	noun	습기	wetness	That is because of the cloud moisture and dust in them.
storm	noun	폭풍	very heavy rain usually with thunder and lightening	Storm clouds form when warm air and cold air meet.
pick up	verb	들어올리다	to take and raise into the air	That is because tornadoes pick up things and throw those things around.
predict	verb	예측하다	to guess about the future	Then they use this information to predict possible tornadoes.
radar	noun	전파 탐지기	a machine that uses sound waves to measure the distance and speed of things	A radar tower like this can be used to track tornadoes.
spin	verb	회전하다	to turn in a circle many times	A tornado is a quickly spinning column of air.
vortex	noun	소용돌이	a spinning body of air, water, smoke, etc.	A vortex must come from a cloud and touch the ground to be a real tornado.

sirens	noun	사이렌	a warning device that makes a loud noise	These sirens can be used to warn people of a tornado.
