lizard	noun	도마뱀	a small reptile that has a long body and short legs	David often goes to the pet store and looks at the lizards.
scale	noun	비늘	one of many small, thin, hard plates that cover the body of some animals, such as a fish	A snakes body is covered in smooth scales.
break	verb	깨다	to make something come apart so it stops working and cannot be easily put back together	Mirror is easy to break. Be careful!
crawl	verb	엎드려 기다	to move along with the body close to the ground	The soldier crawled slowly toward the top of the hill.
claw	noun	발톱	a long, sharp, and usually curved nail of an animal	The bear had very sharp claws.
taste	verb	맛보다	to briefly experience something to see what it is like and if more is wanted	Never before have I tasted defeat like this.
tongue	noun	혀	the soft, movable piece of flesh, inside the mouth, used for tasting, eating and, in people, for talking	You taste food with your tongue.
strange	adj	이상한	different, unusual	At first the place was strange to me.
skin	noun	피부	the natural, outer covering that protects an animal's or person's body	My skin is red because I have a sunburn.
