pipe	noun	배관	a tube which gases and liquids can flow through	The construction worker carried a pipe to the top of the building.
manhole	noun	맨홀	a hole through which a person can gain access to an underground structure	The robber won't see it because it looks like a manhole cover.
mine	noun	탄광	a place where people dig into the earth to obtain minerals	If these mines were good, they would make a lot of money.
coal	noun	석탄	a hard black substance that is taken from the ground and burned for fuel	When the coals are red, they are very hot.
diamond	noun	다이아몬드	a very hard and valuable stone	The diamond found in Russia was very large and valuable.
gas	noun	가스	a substance without a fixed shape that is like air and is neither liquid nor solid	Steam is created when water turns into gas.
cave	noun	동굴	a large opening in the ground or in the side of a hill	Many bats flew out of the caves.
underground	noun	지하	in a space below the surface of the Earth	The Morlocks lived underground.
