opera	noun	오페라	music where a story is sung while instruments play	It's strange that a country that was once a penal colony would have a famous opera house.
oval	adj	계란형의	having the shape of an egg	Footy is a different in that it is played on an oval field.
penal	adj	형벌의	used as a place of punishment for a crime	Cook thought Australia would be good for farming, but the British government used it as a penal colony.
prisoner	noun	죄수	a person who is being held because they broke the law	Many of the first Australians were prisoners sent from England.
