curious	adj	호기심있는	to wonder about something	Europeans heard about distant continents and became curious about them and wanted to see them.
folktale	noun	민간설화	a story that has its beginning in popular culture	Some Native American tribes had folktales about how the world was created.
freshwater	adj	민물의	water that is not salty	North America has a lot of freshwater in its lakes and rivers.
giant	adj	거대한	being extremely large or significantly larger in comparison to other things of the same type	Paul Bunyan is a famous giant in the folklore of the USA.
hemisphere	noun	반구	half of Earth	The whole North American continent is located within the northern hemisphere and the western hemisphere.
hero	noun	영웅	a person who does something brave or important in a story or folktale	North America has stories of folk heroes, such as Paul Bunyan.
immigrant	noun	이민자	someone who leaves their country to live in another	Many immigrants began coming to North America during the 1800s.
independence	noun	독립	freedom	The people wanted their independence from the King of England.
jewelry	noun	보석류	ornaments such as necklaces, bracelets, earrings, or rings worn by men and women	The Native Americans made some beautiful jewelry.
literature	noun	문학	written works	American literature is some of the best in the world.
natural resources	noun	천연자원	useful parts of land, such as water, wood, oil, and soil	The natural resources of North America include wood, oil, and farmland.
population	noun	인구	the number of people living in a city.	The population of the US is about 300 million

population	noun	인구	country, or continent	people.
prosper	verb	번영하다	to grow and succeed	Because of the natural resources in North America, the people were able to prosper.
settle	verb	정착하다	to make new land home	Many of the immigrants to North America settled in the east.
