announcement	noun	발표	a statement that tells people about something	Sally’s teacher made an announcement about a spelling bee.
brag	verb	자랑하다	to talk about yourself and show too much pride	Sally thought that Annika liked to brag about how smart she was.
broccoli	noun	브로콜리	a green vegetable	Sally didn’t like to eat broccoli, but she knew how to spell it.
catastrophe	noun	재앙	something terrible that happens	A catastrophe happened to Annika when she misspelled “embarrassment.”
chopsticks	noun	젓가락	two sticks that are used for eating	Jun taught Sally how to use chopsticks to eat her food.
congratulate	verb	축하하다	to tell someone you are happy he or she is successful	Everyone congratulated Sally because she won the spelling bee.
distracted	adj	산만해진	not able to think about something	Sally was distracted in class, and did not listen to the teacher.
dizzy	adj	어지러운	feeling like you are spinning in circles when you are not	She became dizzy because she couldn’t remember how to spell the word.
embarrassed	adj	당황한	to feel foolish, confused, or stupid in front of other people	Jun was not embarrassed when he could not spell the word correctly.
giddy	adj	어지러운	playful and silly	When she won the spelling bee, Sally was giddy.
glance	verb	흘끗 보다	to look at someone or something quickly	Sally glanced around the room and saw Jun.
goal	noun	목표	something a person is trying to do	Even though Sally didn’t win the second spelling bee, she had already reached her goal.
shrug	verb	으쓱하다	to raise your shoulders to show you don’t care about something	When Brian misspelled “giddy,” he just shrugged.
take a breath	verb	호흡하다	to breath air in and let it out to	When Sally thought about Annika and the spelling

sign	verb	안숨쉬나	show you are bored or upset	bee she sighed.
