ammonia	noun	암모니아	a colorless gas with a strong smell, which people use for cleaning	If we could smell Jupiter, it would have the strong smell of ammonia.
asteroid	noun	소행성	any of the many small, irregularly shaped rocky objects that orbit the Sun	An asteroid could be very dangerous for us if it hit Earth.
atmosphere	noun	대기	the layer of gases around a star or planet	Earth is the perfect planet for us because we can breathe in its atmosphere.
comet	noun	혜성	a natural object in space that leaves a bright tail behind it when it passes near the Sun	When Earth passes through a comet's tail, we can see a meteor shower.
convection	noun	대류	the flow of heat in a gas or liquid	In the convection zone of the sun, energy moves from the radiation zone towards the sun's atmosphere.
crater	noun	분화구	a bowl-shaped hole caused by an object from space hitting the surface of a planet or moon	Our moon has many craters that look like dark spots to us.
dwarf planet	noun	왜소 행성	a round natural object that orbits the Sun but has very weak gravity	Pluto used to be called a planet, but because it is so small it is now called a dwarf planet.
gravity	noun	중력	the force that causes one object to be pulled toward another object	The sun's gravity holds all the planets so they can't slip out of orbit.
meteoroid	noun	유성체	any of the many small rocky objects that travel through outer space	We can see a flash of light when some meteoroids enter Earth's atmosphere.
moon	noun	달	a large, round natural object that orbits a planet such as the Earth	From Earth, we can only see one side of our moon
orbit	verb	궤도	to move in a circular path around a star, planet, or moon	It takes our moon twenty-eight days to orbit one time around Earth.
planet	noun	행성	a large, round natural object that orbits a star such as the Sun and has strong	There are only eight planets that orbit our

			gravity	sun.
polar ice cap	noun	극관 얼음	an area at the top or bottom of a planet that is completely covered in ice	Mars is like Earth because it has polar ice caps.
radiation	noun	방사선	a form of energy that comes from nuclear reactions	Radiation from the sun warms our planet.
