appreciate	verb	감상하다	to value something	Mozart thought that people in a big city would appreciate his work.
concert	noun	콘서트	a musical performance	In Vienna, Mozart performed his music in concerts.
concerto	noun	협주곡	a kind of music written for an orchestra and a solo instrument, such as a piano or violin	Mozart made money by writing concertos and performing in them.
conductor	noun	지휘자	a person who directs the musicians in an orchestra	Mozart’s father was a conductor for the Prince Archbishop.
dazzle	verb	눈이 부시다	to astonish and surprise	When he was a child, Wolfgang dazzled audiences with his performances.
earn	verb	돈을 벌다	to make money	Though Mozart continued to write music in the late 1780s, he did not earn much money.
era	noun	시대	a period of time in history	In the Classical era, there was no one better than Mozart.
fortune	noun	행운	luck	In Vienna, Wolfgang hoped to find fame and fortune.
genius	noun	천재	a person of rare talent and ability	Certainly, Mozart was one of the great musical geniuses of any era.
harpsichord	noun	하프시코드	an early type of piano	The first instrument Mozart learned to play was the harpsichord.
inspire	verb	영감을 주다	to cause someone to want to do or make something	Haydn’s music inspired Mozart to write more music.
mass	noun	미사	a religious service in Christianity	One man wanted Mozart to write a Requiem Mass for his dead wife.
				Mozart composed his last symphony in 1788, the same year he wrote his last piano concerto.

multiple	adj	복수의	more than one	Mozart learned to play multiple instruments.
orchestra	noun	오케스트라	a group of people playing musical instruments	When he was still very young, Mozart wrote music for a full orchestra.
