hardship	noun	곤란, 고충	pain, difficulty, loss, and suffering	They experienced many hardships in a short time.
reward	noun	보수, 보상	something, often money, given or received in return for good work or behavior	A reward will be given to the person who solves the crime.
bow	noun	머리를 숙이다	to bend the head or body forward to express respect, thanks, or as a welcome	It is polite to bow when meeting a king.
curious	adj	호기심이 강한	being interested in something and wanting to learn more about it	The curious child asks a lot of questions.
arrange	verb	배열하다	to organize things or people in a particular way	She arranged the pictures above the fireplace.
jewel	noun	보석	a cut and polished precious stone like a diamond, ruby, sapphire, etc.	The queen’s crown has many colorful jewels.
double	verb	두 배가 되다	to become twice as great in size or degree	We need to double the number of seats at this table.
rule	verb	지배하다, 통치하다	to have control or influence	The king ruled for seventy years.
blessing	noun	축복	God's help	Parents think their children are wonderful blessings.
sharp	adj	날카로운, 뾰족한	having a thin edge or point that is able to cut or make a hole in something	My mind is sharp in the morning.
serve	verb	제공하다	to give a person or group a service that is needed	The waiter served the drinks first.
honor	verb	이행하다	to fulfill an agreement	I wonder if he will honor his promise to marry her.
