| ash | noun | 재, 먼지 | a white and gray powder left after something is burned | The campers poured water over the ashes. |
| tight | adj | 단단히, 꽉 | having little or no room to move | These shoes are too tight. |
| point | noun | 장소, 지점 | a specific place | The two lines cross at a point in the middle of the paper. |
| diamond | noun | 다이아몬드 | a very hard and valuable stone | Most women love to get diamonds as gifts. |
| common | adj | 흔한 | easy to find | Kangaroos are common in Australia. |
| bulb | noun | 전구 | a round container that holds light | The bulb shattered when it hit the floor. |
| lightning | noun | 번개 | a flash of electricity in the sky during a storm | Lightning struck the ground and started a forest fire. |
| melt | verb | 녹다 | to change from a solid to a liquid | The ice cubes melted in the water. |
| compress | verb | 압축하다, 꾹 누르다 | to push something into a smaller space | The air is compressed into the car’s tires. |
| freeze | verb | 얼다 | to change from a liquid to a solid | Water freezes at zero degrees Celsius. |
