breed	verb	새끼를 낳다	to produce babies by having sexual relations with a member of the opposite sex	Cat breeders breed cats to have different looks.
chase	verb	뒤쫓다	to run after something while trying to catch it	Cheetahs are very fast and can catch other animals when they chase them.
extinct	adj	멸종된	no longer any living animals in a group	People worry that the Siberian tiger may soon become extinct.
feral	adj	거친, 돌아다니며 사는	existing in a wild state	Feral cats can be a problem in some cities.
grassland	noun	풀밭, 초원	open land covered with grass	Tigers may live in jungles, but lions usually live in grasslands.
habitat	noun	서식지, 거주	a kind of place where an animal usually lives	When people move into the habitats of wild cats, the cats have to leave.
litter	noun	같은 때에 태어난 새끼들	a group of young animals born at the same time from the same mother	An ordinary house cat can have a litter of six kittens.
litter box	noun	애완 동물용 변기	a box with sand, or other material, that a cat uses as its toilet	Cats that live in the house are often trained to use a litter box.
mammal	noun	포유류	a large group of animals that have fur or hair and make milk for their babies	Because cats have fur and give milk to their babies, cats are part of the mammal family.
mane	noun	갈기	the long fur around a male lion's head	It is easy to tell a male lion by his mane.
pride	noun	자부심, 긍지	a group of lions	Unlike other wild cats, lions live together in a family group known as a pride.
purr	verb	가르릉 거리다	to make a soft sound when happy	When a cat is happy, it purrs.
ruff	noun	동물의 목 주위에 있는 털	fur, like a collar, around the head or neck	The Canadian lynx looks interesting with a ruff of fur around its head.
sensitive	adj	민감한, 예민한	able to feel a light touch or small changes in the air	The thin hairs on a cat's face are very sensitive to touch.
