ancestor	noun	조상	a person from whom one is descended, more distant than a grandfather	The first people to come to North America from Asia were ancestors of the Native Americans.
bend	noun	굴곡	a curve, especially a sharp one, in a road or river	People want to travel around the river bend to see what is there.
curiosity	noun	호기심	a desire to learn something new	One of the reasons that people like to travel is because of their curiosity about the world.
desire	noun	열망, 욕망	a strong feeling of wanting or wishing for something	Explorers are people who have a desire to see a new place or get glory or money.
explorer	noun	탐험가	someone who goes to different places to see new things	John Wesley Powell was an American explorer who led a scientific trip through the Grand Canyon.
fleet	noun	함대	a group of ships	Zheng He took a huge fleet of ships from China all the way to Africa.
frozen	adj	얼은	covered with ice	Antarctica is a frozen land that was one of the last places to be explored.
glory	noun	영광, 명예	greatness or honor	The athletes competed for the glory of their country.
journey	noun	짧은 여행	a long trip	Roald Amundsen made a difficult journey to the South Pole in 1911.
missionary	noun	선교사	a person who travels to spread a religion	David Livingstone was a Scottish missionary who traveled through Africa by himself.
navigator	noun	항해사	a person who steers ships or conducts explorations by sea	Prince Henry of Portugal was called Henry the Navigator because he paid people to find better trade routes.
priest	noun	신부	a person who carries out religious ministry	Jacques Marquette was a priest who traveled with the explorer Louis Joliet to take Christianity to the Indians around the Great Lakes.

route	noun	길, 경로	a way to get somewhere	Many explorers were looking for trade routes from Europe to China.
translate	verb	번역하다	to change from one language into another	Xuanzang collected books about Buddhism in India and translated them into Chinese.
